Dear Friends,

Sincere thanks to you all for so many cards, gifts & kind messages as I reluctantly prepare to leave this ministry in Greenwich. It has been nothing less than an exhausting and joyful privilege to serve these two parishes for nearly 14 years. It is gratifying to know that the task I undertook in 2011 with two churches, will now occupy three resident priests! And so, it was great to welcome more than 200 people to the Clarendon last week. Truthfully so many that I don't know who was there and who wasn't. I am very touched by all your affection, & even that there were grown men in tears! But that perturbs me: Our purpose collectively is to build up the Body of Christ as a community where people know that they are embraced with the love of God and reach out to receive Christ in the palm of their hands. That ministry belongs to everybody! In some respects, I am more conscious of my failures than successes. If there is anybody I have neglected or hurt please forgive me. I am often too casual or careless with my use of words & language. I am mindful that I should have done more to develop lay ministry especially at the Star of the Sea. More than anything I am conscious that in these years I have failed to get the Star of the Sea towards a proper state of restoration. After several false starts, I applaud the initiative that

Brian is taking, biting the bullet with the appointment of a conservation architect & all the related professional expenses. Back in my early years our church did not generate sufficient income to support such initiative. Whether we do today is still a fragile proposition? Hopefully once the project is rolling it will generate its own momentum. The communal

drive of removing the old floor tiles is a significant step in that direction.

From September you should welcome Fr Tom Lynch. I know that you will be as generous and supportive to him as you have been to me. He is a good & cheerful man who clearly loves his people, some of whom have phoned to say how distressed they are to lose him from Strood. Aged just 40, I now soberly realise that he is nearly 30 years younger than me. He will be able to devote himself exclusively to OLSS without charging across the park on a bicycle. It is already more than 30 years since we left the CofE. Every week I would drive, in my home made Mini, with my old mate Fr Graham Preston, all the way to Guildford to spend two nights at the seminary. We would always get stuck in traffic beside the famous - Holy Trinity Wandsworth. Here is a thriving evangelical CofE church, but I fear very different to what we might be familiar with as Catholics. We would look at the notice board by the road with bemused curiosity. Under the name of the "Minister" was written: "The Congregation". We used to speculate how that might work for weddings? Nevertheless, they something: "Every onto Ministry" should equally be a maxim for Catholics! St Paul warns us to consider how we contribute to the building up of God's church...

"If anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire". ICor3v12 It is part of the purgatorial test. I may not have built with silver & gold but you are all the "Precious Stones" and I have done my level best!




